Within the first week of school, most of the students and staff were able to go to a Christian medical conference together about an hour and a half from here. The students were exposed to speakers from all over the world, quality discipleship, and were able to make new friends and connections. It was a blessed time for everyone.

Dano recently put together an ad for an Egyptian nursing school director as well as an ad for certified nurses to work at the hospital and sent it to a few people. One of our friends responded, “I just sent your ad to all 3,000 of my email contacts, so you might be getting some inquiries.” Sure enough, we began getting calls and texts within the quarter hour. We are thankful for the interest and are praying for people to be led here who have a heart for the gospel— people who see “Christian” as more than just a label on their birth certificates and driver’s licenses.

Financial Update

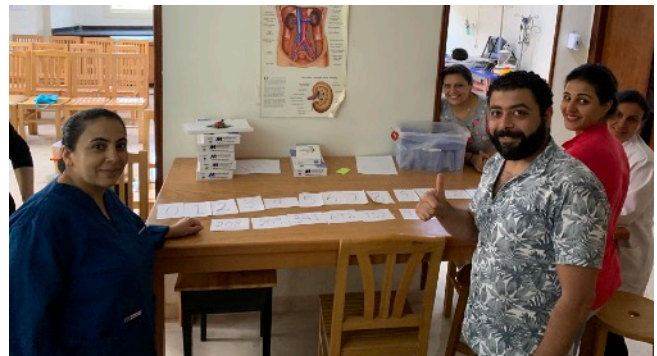
